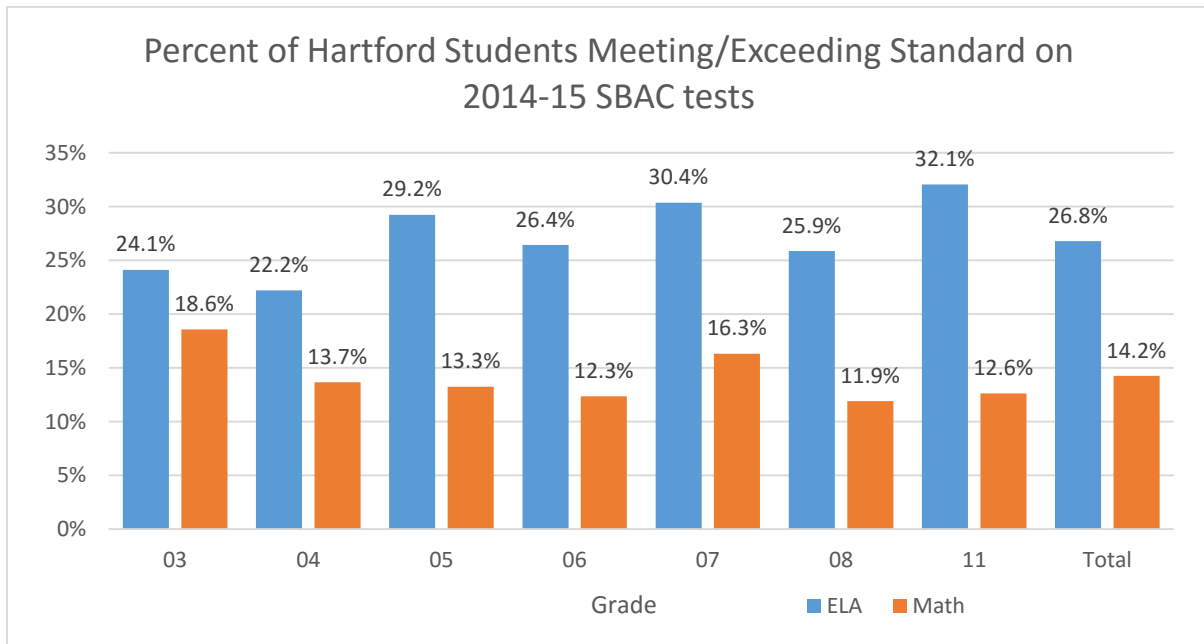


How did Hartford perform on the SBAC in 2015?

Overall, just over 1 in 4 (26.8%) Hartford students met or exceeded the standard in English Language Arts (ELA), while just 1 in 7 (14.2%) Hartford students met or exceeded the standard in Math. Highest scores posted came in ELA in Grade 11, where about 1 in 3 (32.1%) students met or exceeded the new standard. Lowest scores posted were in ELA in grade 4, where only 22.2% met or exceeded the new standard.



How did Hartford’s high schools perform?

Similar to the CAPT, Hartford’s magnet high schools (shaded in green) tended to outperform non-magnet schools in ELA. The exception to this was Sports and Medical Sciences Academy, which performed below some neighborhood schools in ELA. Achievement First Hartford Academy was the highest performing high school in Hartford, with 64.5% of students meeting or exceeding the standard in ELA. Alarmingly, the lowest performing school in ELA was Culinary Arts Academy, which had less than 5% of its students meeting or exceeding the standard. Schools with stars did not have enough data to report.

Math scores were rough in this first year of SBAC administration, with *almost all of Hartford's neighborhood schools reporting less than 5% of its students meeting the standard in Math.* Two high schools, Achievement First (45.2%) and University High School of Science and Engineering (43.3%), both scored miles above the pack in Math.

How did Hartford's elementary and middle schools perform?

At the elementary and middle school levels, there are some higher performing neighborhood schools, such as West Middle, Global, Naylor and Sanchez, which produced ELA scores similar to some of the HPS magnet schools and even *outperform* some magnet schools in Math. There was a huge disparity between schools on the top and bottom of the list, with variation above 50 points in ELA and 40 points in Math. Similar to high schools, there is a huge need to improve Math scores moving forward. Of particular concern should be the performance of Betances Early Reading Lab on the ELA test. *Half of Hartford's elementary/middle schools had less than 10% of their students meeting the achievement level in Math.*
