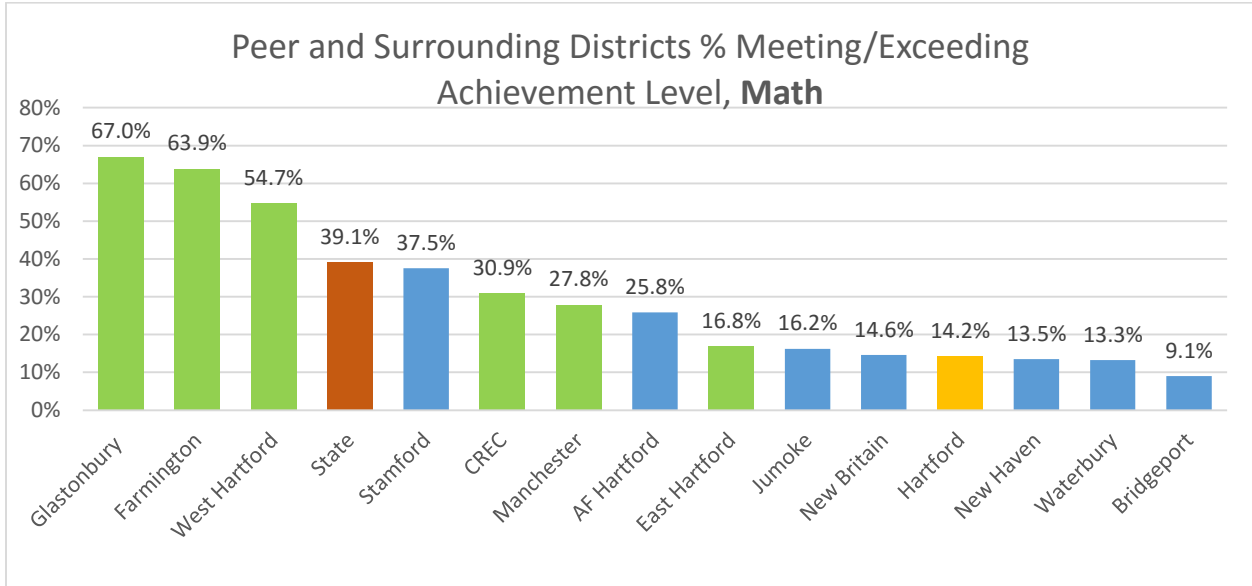


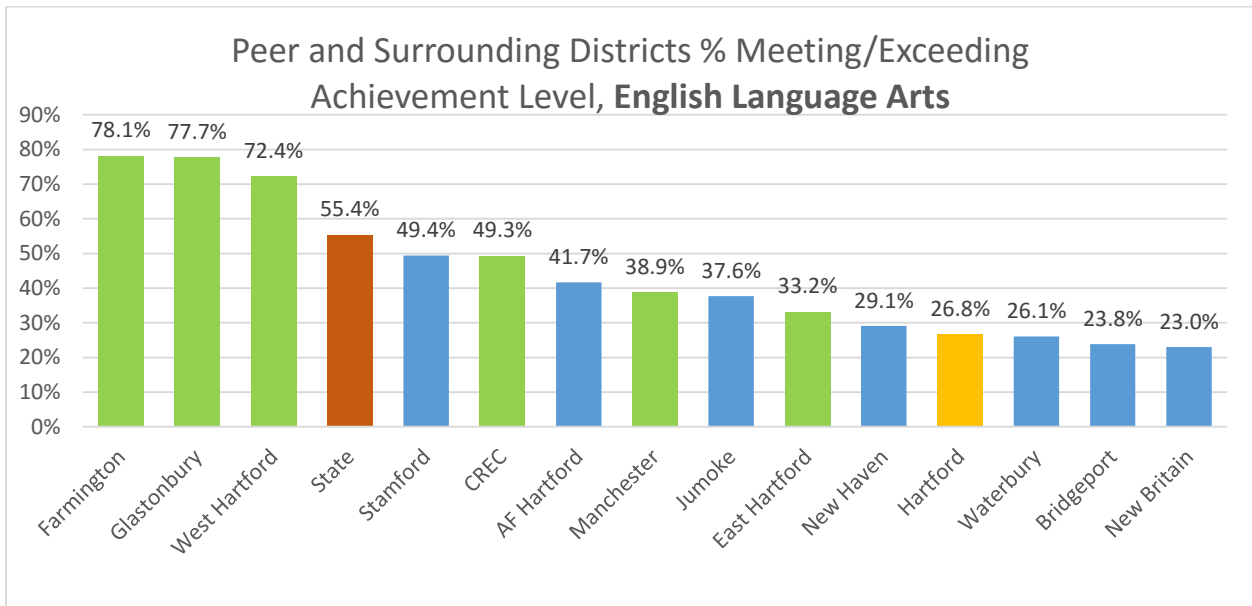


**How did Hartford students perform compared to peer districts, surrounding districts, and the State?**

In the following charts, Hartford is represented in yellow, the State average in red, surrounding districts in green, and peer districts in blue. The results for each school district are averages of all grades' performances.



In Math, Hartford managed to outperform peer districts New Haven, Waterbury, and Bridgeport, while performing lower than New Britain and Stamford. All peer urban districts performed below the State average. The gap between Hartford and its surrounding suburban districts is very evident here, with gaps around 50 points between Hartford and Glastonbury and Farmington.



In English Language Arts (ELA), Hartford outperformed Waterbury, Bridgeport and New Britain, while performing lower than New Haven and Stamford. All peer urban districts performed below the State average. Hartford saw a 50+ point gap between its performance and some of its surrounding suburban districts, like Farmington and Glastonbury.

***How did Hartford’s high schools perform compare to peer high schools across the state?***

Data for high schools in Bridgeport, Hartford, New Haven, Stamford and Waterbury are included in the table below, which also includes CREC high schools.

Looking at 11<sup>th</sup> Grade ELA performance in the table above, there are four Hartford high schools that scored in the top 10, and unfortunately five Hartford high schools in the bottom 10 of urban high schools in the state. Alarming, the lowest performing urban high school in the state on the ELA assessment was Hartford's Culinary Arts Academy at Weaver, which had less than 5% of students meeting or exceeding the standard. Schools with stars (\*) lacked enough data to report.

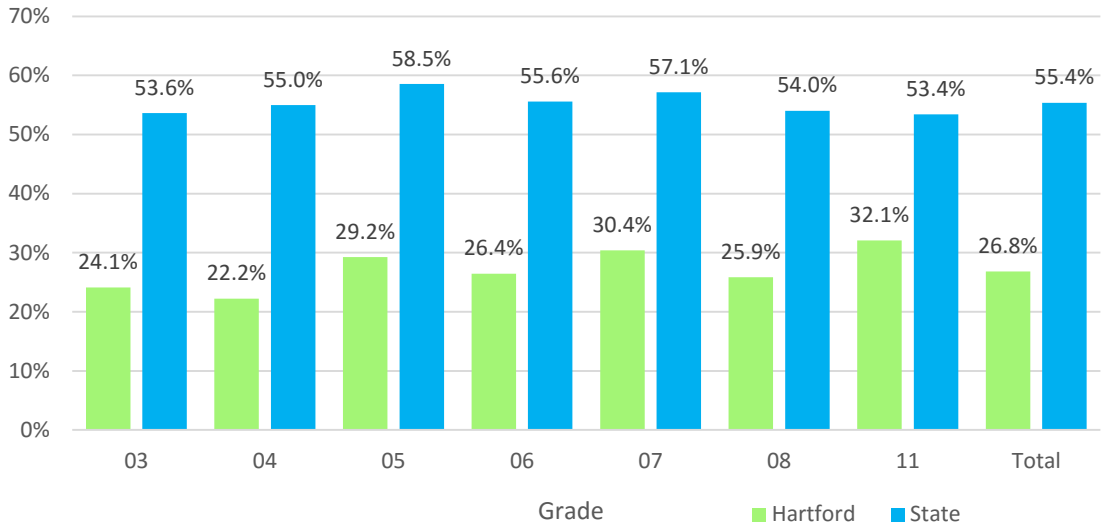

Looking at 11<sup>th</sup> Grade Math scores, there are two Hartford high schools, Achievement First (45.2%) and University High School for Science and Engineering (43.3%), in the top five. Unfortunately, all of Hartford's neighborhood schools with data had less than 5% of its students meeting the achievement level in Math.

***How did the performance of Hartford students in each grade compare to the State average?***

Both Math and ELA scores saw a huge gap between Hartford students and the State average. Overall, Hartford scored 28.6 points below the State average in ELA, and 24.9 points lower in Math. This means that the gap is more than double of Hartford's score in both subjects. The gap was lowest for both subjects in grade 11 (21.3 points in ELA and 18 points in Math), while highest in 3<sup>rd</sup> grade (29.5 points in ELA and 29.4 points in Math).
